What is a Life Group?

- Life Groups are a weekly gathering in a home with people from our community where relationships grow and deepen, and we encourage one another to be disciples of Jesus and to make disciples.
- Following Jesus and the relationships we have with one another are not intended to be only once a week-LifeGroups are where Jesus and real life meet together.
- Life Groups are adult-focused and kid-friendly

What happens at Life Group?

- We will explore God's Word together and have some great discussion time
- We will help each other apply what God is saying to us and challenge each other in next steps
- We get to pray for and with one another
- We also encourage groups to eat together and share life together outside of Life Groups

Where are Life Groups located?

Life Groups typically meet at the home of the life group leader. There are 4-current LifeGroup locations & 2-upcoming LifeGroup Locations:

- Neenah (Dave & Kara Koeller meets on Tuesday nights and launches on Tues., October 3rd)
- Appleton Central (Leng & Usanee Yang meets on Thursday nights and launches on Thurs., October 5th)
- Fox Crossing (Andy & Kaylen Nickols meets on Thursday nights and launches on Thurs., October 5th)
- Oshkosh (Edgar & Kayla Gomez meets on Friday nights and launches on Fri., October 6th)

How do I get plugged into a Life Group?

• Sign up at church for the Life Group that is nearest to your home. The Life Group leader will then connect with you. If you have questions, connect with the leader of the Life Group closest to you.

How do Life Groups help fulfill the mission of God?

- Life Groups will enable us to reach the world for Jesus one person at a time and ignite a movement of Multi-Ethnic Christ followers to reach, develop and send the next generations (2 Corinthians 5:18, 20; Luke 19:10; 2 Peter 3:9).

Life Groups seek to be an open and safe place for you to share what's going on in your life in a confidential setting. We desire to work through conflict and value relationships and connecting while exploring what it means to follow Christ. This is a place to be heard and to listen. We value discovering your gifts and actively using them in the church. We desire that people would choose to consistently attend and actively engage.

What's the difference between a Life Group & a Small Group?

Life Groups may be similar to what you've experienced in the past in a small group and while the differences may seem minor, they are significant. We want this experience to go beyond the group leader and curriculum - affecting all aspects of our lives and for each member to take an active role in pouring into the group during and outside of the scheduled meeting time.
